The Ronald McDonald Camp, founded in the early 1970’s by Dr. Audrey Evans, is a place where the children who withstand the harsh and painful treatments associated with cancer have the opportunity to laugh, have fun and enjoy being kids. Maria Jacobs, part owner of the nursery, volunteers one week a year at the camp, where she teaches arts and crafts.
